- JEEP stoves or the energy saving stoves, that made life better for household members. They have smoke free kitchen that even men support in the cooking, rarely fetched fire wood and with others it is a business now.
- Fireless Baskets cookers made an end to taking cold food. The Baskets cook and keep food for family members who miss lunch especially the school going children, keeps baby milk warm, created peace at homes as result the reduced burden to warm food for husbands.
- Backyard Gardening. After the trainings, the community learnt that each meal should have vegetables on it and that it is good to grow your own vegetables than buying them.

- Tree Nursery. With support from JEEP, 2 community members were trained in nursery establishment and management and supported to establish a Nursery. These farmers have been able to raise over 1,800

seedlings of different varieties Oranges, Mangoes, Pawpaws, Misizi, soursop /Ekitaferi, Eucalyptus, Ovacados, Albizia. The Nursery has created employment and improved access of both fruit and trees to the community of Nakasongola.

Through the district Production and Natural resources department, we pledge to continue guiding, following up and scaling out the good practices. We are looking forward for more future collaboration.

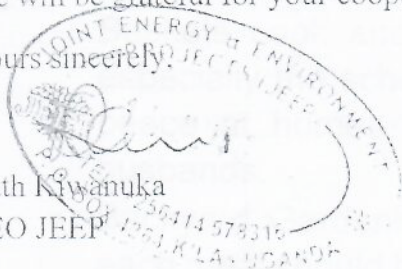
JEEP is therefore requesting your support in monitoring the trained beneficiaries to ensure that the gained knowledge in the project continues being expanded to all villages in the sub counties.
